Instructions:

1. Fold the Pool Party Cardstock in half to create card base.
2. Glue the Whisper White piece to the Basic Black mat and glue both to the Pool Party card front.
3. Stamp the bicycle in Versamark ink on the Whisper White cardstock, apply Black Stampin' Emboss Powder and heat set.
4. Stamp "I'm here for you..." in versamark and apply Black Stampin' Emboss Powder on scrap of Whisper White and heat set.
5. Stamp "let me pedal for a while" in Versamark on Basic Black scrap with White Stampin' Emboss Powder and heat set.
6. Colour the bicycle with a variety of Stampin' Write Markers. I used Bermuda Bay, Smoky Slate, Basic Gray and Crushed Curry.
7. Add a strip of Washi tape below bike and glue black strip on top. Trim to fit.
8. Cut out "I'm here for you..." into individual words and glue above bike.
9. Punch out 5 banner pieces with punch from the scraps of Schoolhouse Designer Paper.
10. Use Washi Tape to stick down a "string" of Baker's Twine and pop up banners along the string.
11. Add some Rhinestones to the banners.
12. Enjoy!

***Tip** – when I emboss (especially with black) I also swipe the Embossing Buddy over my paper to remove any "residue" from my fingers so that the Stampin' Emboss powder only sticks to the image and not to oils on the paper.
